About R2D2 – MH project:

Risk and Resilience in Developmental Diversity and Mental Health (R2D2 - MH) is an international research project that aims to improve the mental health (MH) outcomes of adolescents and adults with neurodevelopmental diversity (NDD).

The **overall goal of R2D2** is to improve the MH outcomes across the lifespan for neurodivergent individuals based on: 1) enhanced molecular and neurobiological understanding of risk and resilience to poor MH outcomes for neurodivergent people; 2) redefinition of mental health and functioning by co-creation of acceptable outcome measures with stakeholders.

Who are we looking for?

We are looking for **adolescents** who are **neurodivergent** to inform work undertaken within the R2D2 – MH project.

Profile of participants:

- Autistic or ADHD
- Age between 15 18 years old
- Fluent English
- Good communication technology skills

What does a cocreation group do?

To **provide to the researcher's outcome measures** that they consider acceptable and useful (the outcomes selected will guide the whole R2D2 project and will be integrated into a positive psychology App and a digital clinical portal.

To **provide feedback on the progress of the project** (mainly about issues related to the development of the App and Clinical portal)

What do we expect?

- Cocreation group is integral part of the research.
- Input from the cocreation group is **vital** for the project.
- Participants are allowed and expected to ask questions regarding the project.
- Group will discuss the research that is in development and will communicate ideas, opinions and feedback to the researchers.

How the meetings will look like?

• All meetings will be in **English**.





- They will be a safe space where participants can trust each other and the researchers.
- Participants will be asked about their needs and expectations to be comfortable as members of the cocreation group.
- R2D2 research members sometimes will join in the meetings (e.g. to explain what there
 are doing at some point and get their feedback)
- Participation will be paid according to the R2D2 resources (400 euros per year approx.)

When we will meet?

We will meet on **Saturdays** from **10.30 am to 12.00 pm** (9.30 to 11.00 am in UK and Ireland). It is expected to meet at least once every 2 months.

Meetings will be mainly by Zoom.
